Home EV Charger

- 1. Virginia Property Owners Association Act authorizes the Board to establish reasonable restrictions for EV Chargers.
- 2. Proposal sets rules for individual homeowners to have EV Chargers.
- 3. Does not allow charger stations within the lot or in common areas.
- 4. A charger may be attached to the home, no higher than the windowsill, and must be covered with landscaping.
- 5. All electric lines must be buried and not trip hazards.
- 6. The owner must obtain all permits.
- 7. The Architectural Review Committee must approve.
- 8. Owner must pay all costs.
- 9. The owner must have liability insurance and name association as an additional insured.
